#### M. Sc. (Data Science & Spatial Analytics) Batch No 2026-2028

##### ELIGIBILITY

Graduate in Engineering, IT, Science, Computer Science, and Computer Application of any recognised university/ Institution of National Importance with 50% minimum of marks or equivalent grade (45% Marks or equivalent grade for Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes).

#### Master of Science (Data Science & Spatial Analytics) - Dual Degree Programme Batch No 2026-2028

##### ELIGIBILITY

Graduate in Engineering, IT, Science, Computer Science, and Computer Application of any recognised university/ Institution of National Importance with 50% minimum of marks or equivalent grade (45% Marks or equivalent grade for Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes).

**Note: As part of the dual degree program, students will earn their second degree - Master of Science Degree Technical Systems Control AI & Space Science from RUDN University, Moscow, Russia**

#### M. Sc. (Geoinformatics) Batch No 2026-2028

##### ELIGIBILITY

Graduate in Engineering, IT, Science, Computer Science, Agriculture, Geography, Planning, Architecture, Commerce and Management from any recognized University/ Institution of National Importance with a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade (45% Marks or equivalent grade for Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes).

## M. Tech Geoinformatics Batch No 2026-2028

### ELIGIBILITY

Candidate should be an Engineering Graduate (BE/B. Tech), M.Sc. Geoinformatics, M.Sc. Physics, M.Sc. Geology, M.Sc. Environmental Science, M.Sc. Mathematics, M.Sc. Agriculture or equivalent from any statutory university with a minimum of 50% marks (45% for SC/ST).

Candidates appearing for final year examinations can also apply for M.Sc. and M.Tech Programme's, but their admission will be confirmed subject to obtaining a minimum of 50% marks (45% for SC/ST) at qualifying examination.

A candidate who has completed qualifying qualification from any Foreign University must obtain an equivalence certificate from Association of Indian Universities (AIU).

**Graduates from Open Universities or students having a degree through a correspondence course are NOT eligible.**

**M.Tech Programme:** Valid GATE Qualified Score or Entrance Test for Non-GATE candidates and Personal Interaction will be conducted online
